

SUPREME COURT OF LOUISIANA

O R D E R

Acting under the authority of Article V, Section 1 of Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering continuing need to modify the administration of the Louisiana Bar Examination,

WHEREAS, the Court previously issued Orders dated May 13, 2020, July 22, 2020 and August 12, 2020 amending Part I of the written examination required by Section 7 of Supreme Court Rule XVII;

WHEREAS, the Governor has declared a state of emergency in Proclamation Number 133 JBE 2020 as a result of Hurricane Delta, which is forecast to result in widespread power outages that will adversely impact the administration of the remote bar examination on October 10, 2020; and


WHEREAS, the Louisiana Supreme Court Committee on Bar Admissions has recommended that the October 10, 2020 remote bar examination be postponed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The remote bar examination scheduled for October 10, 2020 will now be administered on Tuesday, October 20, 2020.
2. All other provisions of the August 12, 2020 Order remain unmodified.
